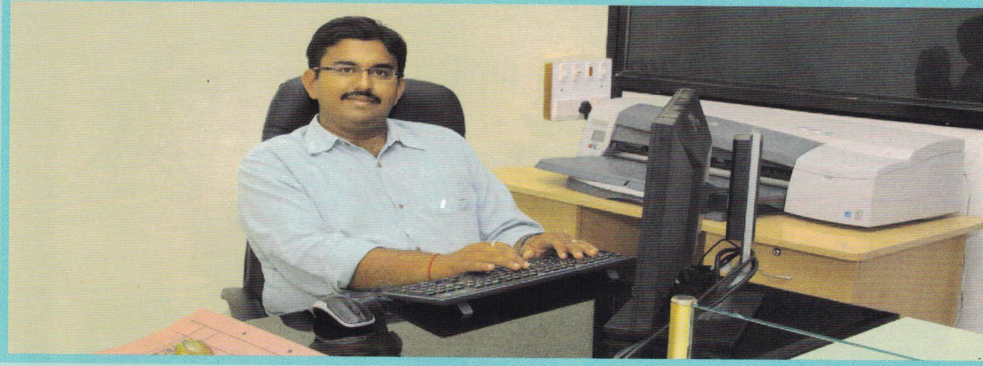
Majority of the students come from adjacent rural localities. To sharpen their English communication skills, English language Laboratory is provided, for student to practice.

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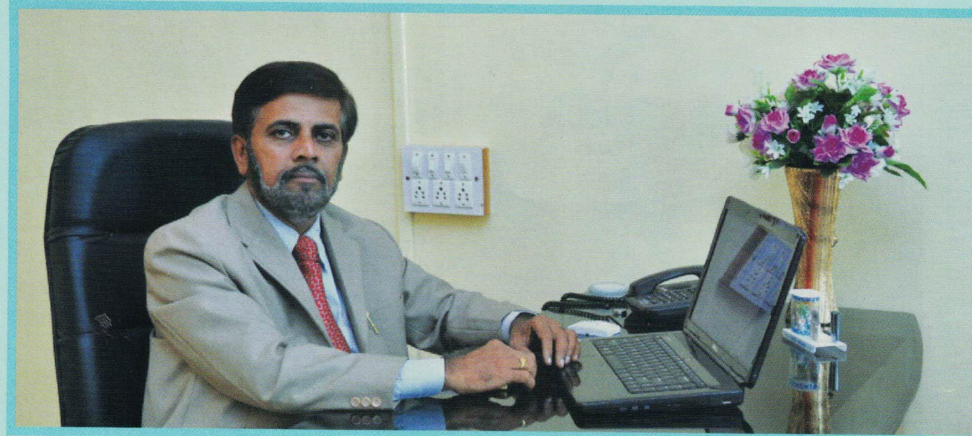

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## Profile of the College

*The objective of MIM is to develop Socially responsible and ethical business leaders through value based education.*



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MIM conducts a two year full time Post Graduate Programme in Business Management (M.B.A.) with specializations in Marketing, Finance, Production and Human resource Management. This M.B.A. is program is affiliated to the University of Pune and approved by AICTE, New Delhi and DTE, Maharashtra. MIM provides value addition to its students by using innovative pedagogic methods like case method of learning, skill development workshops, English language labs, career counseling, guest lectures and industry visits.

### Learning Ambiance

MIM have a contemporary learning ambiance. Lecture rooms are well airy and furnished. Teachings aids including LCD projectors and computer terminals are available for the use of faculty and students.

### Competent and committed faculty

MIM faculty members follow a rigorous but interactive style of teaching. Faculty members are well qualified professionals as per the norms of the University of Pune and AICTE, New Delhi, who have the necessary exposure to industry. Faculty members are drawn from a pool of professionals who have an aptitude for teaching and have a strong commitment to all around development of students.

### Continuous evaluation

Students are exposed to continuous and rigorous process of review through internal evaluation, midterm examinations as well as end term examinations. This ensures that they are constantly alert and are acquiring new learning consistently through the program. The continuous evaluation system ensures that students who have demonstrated commitment and seriousness consistently through the program finish with the best grades.

### I.T. Infrastructure

MIM is equipped with a state of the art computer laboratory with required software installed. Advanced English language lab is established to improve the communication skills of the students. Internet access is provided to students who wish to access the World Wide Web for carrying out research activities.

### Library facilities

MIM is having a library with a good collection of books and reference books, which are made available to students. Library subscribes to a variety of business journals, magazines and newspapers which enable students to keep up with recent literature on management theory and practice.

### Workshop and Lab

MIM organizes special workshops for development of skills such as interpersonal communication, presentation and group discussion. In addition to the above, English labs are conducted to enhance speech and writing skills in English.

### Seminars

Students participate in seminars on management topics organized by professional bodies and also participate in competitions conducted by student bodies.

### Practical Training & Project work

Each student shall have to undergo a practical training for a period of not less than 50 days during the vacation at the end of First Year. Based on actual training during the vacation, the student shall write project report on the topic selected under the guidance of an internal teacher and submit the same to the Director of the institute before the end of Semester III. The Project Report shall be assessed by the Internal Teacher. Basis of a certificate of completion by the concerned teacher that the project report has been satisfactorily completed, that the student would be allowed to appear for the examination of Semester III. There will an external viva-voce based on the project work at the end of Semester III.

**Project Work** is an introduction to the MBA student as to how to handle real-life problem/situation in a business organization by analyzing it and developing the best solution for it. The summer internship program is an invaluable experience for students and is the foundation for high level contribution at an early stage on final placement.





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## M.B.A. Programme

MIM MBA programme offers seats for 120 students. MBA is designed as a 2-year, 4-semester, postgraduate programme with the objective of molding and transforming young graduate students for value driven, competent and committed professional roles. They should be able to give effective leadership in managerial positions in business and non-profit organizations. While the theoretical foundation is structured around the Pune University prescribed syllabus, a number of additions and innovations are provided to prepare the graduates to cope with organizational and societal requirements for the future. 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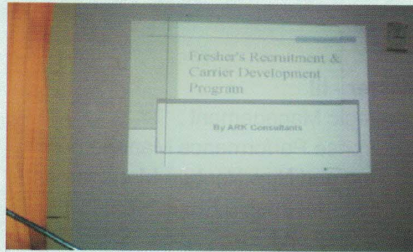

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## Code of Conduct & Discipline Rules

1. Uniform as prescribed by the institute is compulsory for all the students.
2. As specified in university of Pune rule, minimum 75% attendance in each subject is compulsory. A student having less than 75% attendance will not be eligible to appear for examination.
3. Every student must complete prescribed term work as per the completion schedule fixed by the institute.
4. Periodic tests are compulsory & conducted as prescribed in the curriculum. Marks secured by candidate in these regular tests are considered for internal marks.
5. Student must be punctual in attending lectures. Student coming late to the classes will be marked absent.
6. Student must maintain silence & strict discipline within & outside classroom, library, laboratory & all other areas in campus.
7. Student must have their identity card while they are in college campus.
8. Any act on the part of student causing damages to cleanliness of any part of campus will be charged with heavy fine.
9. Religious festival like Holi, Dahihandi etc. will not be permitted in the college campus.
10. Student should not loiter in corridors & should not disturb other.
11. In case, if student wants to remain absent for some reason, he or she will be required to take prior permission of Director or HOD, but will be for limited period.
12. Student shall handle all instrument and equipments with due care. Any loss/damages caused to institute property by students will be recovered from student.
13. Student must read notices displayed on notice board of institute. The institute will not be responsible for the loss of any advantages of the student due to his failure to read the notice in time.
14. Student if found including anti-national activities contrary to rule of discipline will be liable to expelled from the college without any notice by the principal of the college.

### Eligibility :

Students seeking admission to MBA course of university of Pune must be a graduate in any discipline (minimum three years integrated degree course of a statutory university) with 50%(45% in case of student of backward castes belonging to Maharashtra State only). OR The candidate appeared for the final year of any bachelor degree (of a minimum of three years integrated degree course any statutory university) may be considered for provisional admissions.

### Selection Procedure:

The candidate must appear for the Common Management Aptitude Test CMAT (MAH MBA/MMS/CET) GD & PI. Or GMAT (conducted by GNMAT, USA)/CAT (conducted by IIMs)/ JMET (Conducted by IITs)/MAT (conducted by AIMA)/ATMA (conducted by AIMS)/XAT (conducted by the Management of the respective institutes. For latest eligibility criteria and selection procedure, students are advised to visit the website [www.dte.org.in](http://www.dte.org.in)

### Admission through Institute level Quota & Vacant Seats:

The candidates interested in securing admissions, under this quota, in this institute should apply in the prescribed application form available in the Institute's office.
